## **Le jardin communautaire**

### **The Community Garden**

1. Looking at the picture above, ask your child these open questions:

#### **Qui vois-tu?**

Who do you see?

Example French Answer: Je vois cinq enfants et un adulte.

#### **Quelle heure est-il? Pourquoi penses-tu ça?**

What time is it? Why do you think so?

Example Answer: Il est dix heures du matin.

#### **Où sont-ils?**

Where are they?

Example Answer: Ils sont dans un jardin.

#### **Combien de personnes vois-tu?**

How many people do you see?

Example Answer: Je vois six personnes.

**Que font-ils?**

What are they doing?

Example Answer: Ils jardinent.

**Qu'est-ce qu'ils ont cultivé? Comment?**

What did they grow? How?

Example Answer: Ils cultivaient des fleurs, des fruits et des légumes.

**Pourquoi plantent-ils de la nourriture et des fleurs?**

Why are they planting food and flowers?

Example Answer: Ils veulent aider les gens qui n'ont pas de nourriture.

**Comment te sentirais-tu s'ils t'ont invité à les rejoindre?**

How would you feel if they invited you to join them?

Example Answer: Je me sentirais heureuse.

**Que cultiverais-tu dans ton jardin? What would you grow in your garden?**

Example Answer: Je cultiverais des pommes de terre.

2. Help them understand the meaning with the English version of the sentence, by asking them to repeat the question both in French and English.
3. Focus on learning the first word of each question -
4. Qui (Who) Quelle/Que (What) Ou (Where) Combien (How many) Pourquoi (Why) Comment (How).  
  
They may respond in English.
5. Ask them why.
6. After your child gives their answers in English, share the example French answers with them, explaining the meaning and asking them to repeat after you.

**Learning Goal**

The goal is for the student to learn the meaning of common question words such as “Qui” “Combien” “Ou,” etc., and to be able to explain the reason behind their answers
